

DOCTORAL (PhD) CURRICULUM IN RUSSIAN AND SLAVONIC PHILOLOGY (240 ECTS)

Brief description of curriculum

The volume of PhD study is 240 ECTS, of which the instruction in PhD subjects makes up 60 ECTS and PhD research 180 ECTS. PhD study consists of specialty subjects, i.e. Russian Language or Russian Literature (36 ECTS), University-wide elective subjects (12 ECTS, including practice of teaching at the university level six ECTS) and optional subjects (12 ECTS). In conducting their research, PhD students are advised by the supervisor or the supervisor and co-supervisor(s) approved by the Council of the College of Foreign Languages and Cultures. PhD students' progress in research is evaluated during the first academic year twice (in January and in August) and during the other academic years once each academic year (in August) by an Evaluation Board. The requirements established for PhD theses are set out in the Constitutive Rules for the University of Tartu Research Degrees and in the Guidelines for the Defense of PhD Theses of the Council of the College of Foreign Languages and Cultures.
